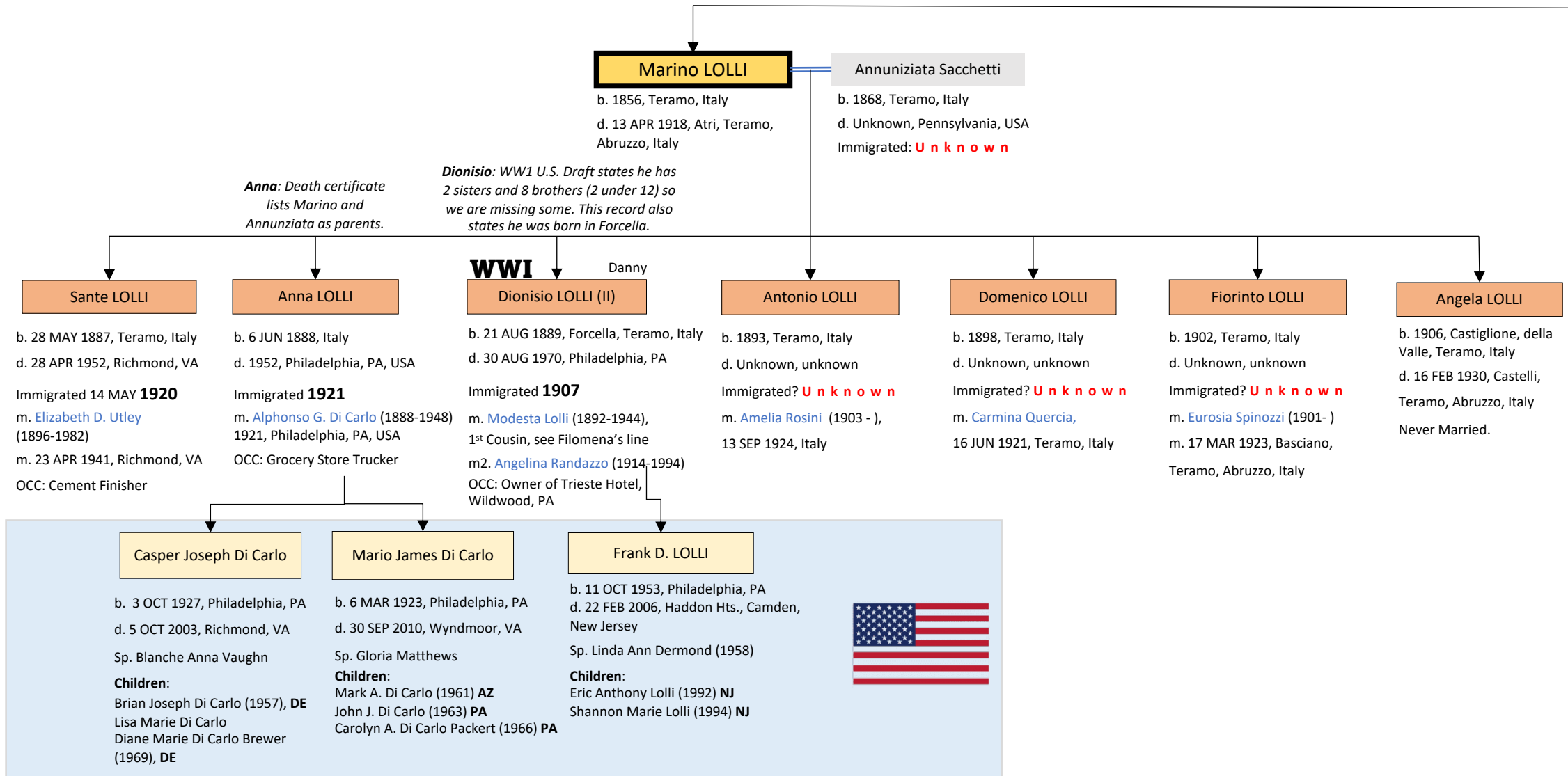

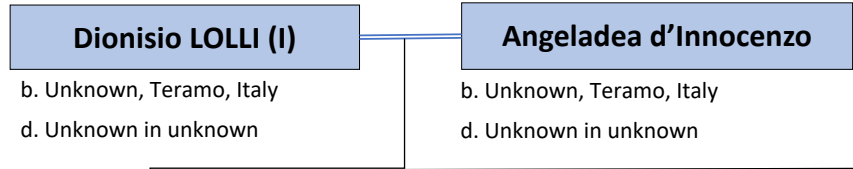

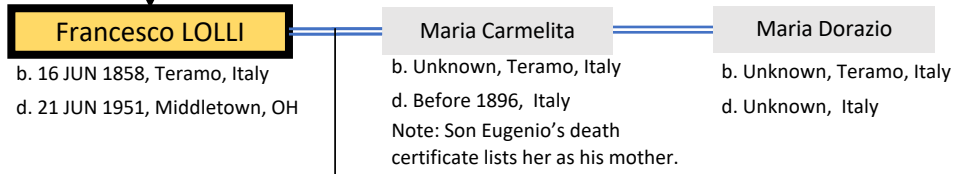

Immigrated 15 APR 1902. These papers state he is from Teramo, Italy and was a farmer.

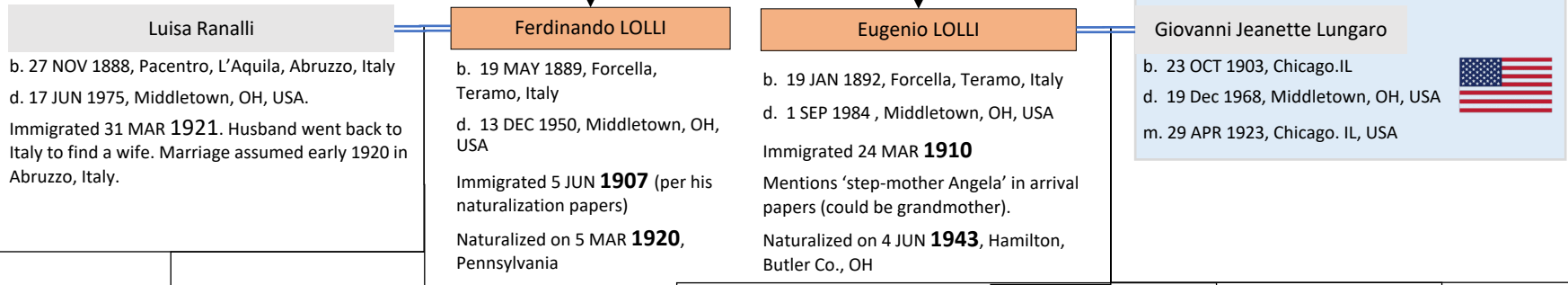

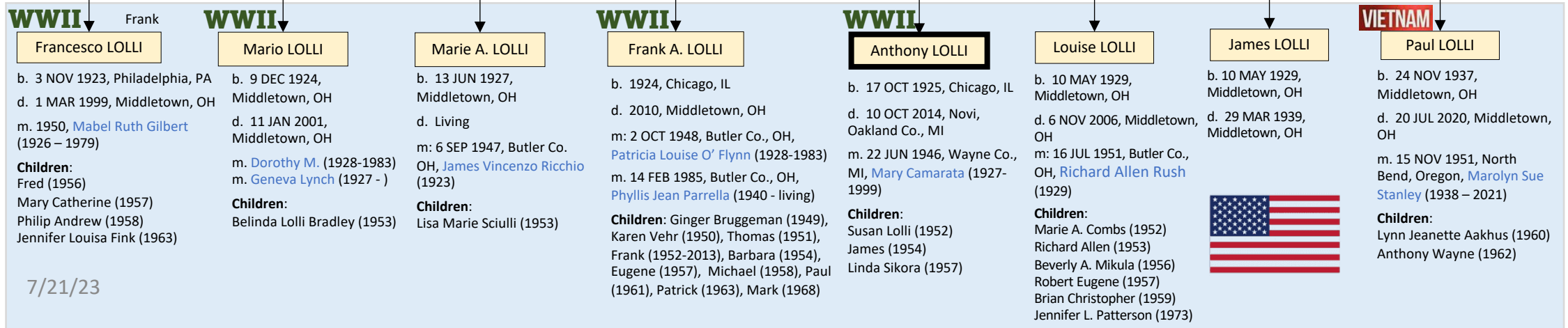
- Birthdate and birthplace from: WW1 Veterans Compensation papers, Naturalization papers, and passport application
